







Sri Lanka Tea Production for the month of March 2022 amounted to 22.02 Mn/Kg, vis-à-vis 28.81 Mn/Kg in 2021. (-6.79 Mn/Kg). Cumulative crop to end March 2022 was 63.10 Mn/Kg, compared with 74.51 Mn/Kg in 2021. (-11.41 Mn/Kg)

Elevation wise analysis shows that for the month of March 2022 High, Medium & Low Growns show a decrease of -1.52Mn/Kg, -1.53Mn/Kg & -3.74Mn/Kg respectively when compared to the same month last year.

CTC's recorded 1.80 Mn/Kg for the month of March 2022 vis-à-vis 2.48 Mn/Kg last year. (-0.68Mn/Kg)

MOMBASA AUCTION OF 25TH/ 26TH & 27TH APRIL 2022

Fairly good demand for the 190,500 packages (12,483,691.00 kilos) in the market with 14.35% neglected.

Egyptian Packers, Pakistan Packers and Bazaar maintained useful interest with Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Kazakhstan and other CIS nations lending good support while UK were more selective. There was reduced enquiry from Sudan and Afghanistan with only minimal purchases from Iran. Russia remained absent. Local Packers were selective on price. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

BP1: Best - Met irregular interest due to price adjustment and ranged between firm to USC50 dearer to easier by up to USC58. Brighter - Varied between steady to USC10 dearer with selected improved teas advancing by up to USC56 to easier by USC10. Mediums - KTDA mediums were fully firm at last rates where sold but a number of invoices remained unsold due to price limits; plantation mediums shed up to USC6. Lower Mediums - Were irregular ranging between steady to USC12 up on previous prices to easier by up to USC14. Plainer - Varied between firm to USC20 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

PF1: Best - Were mostly dearer by USC2 to USC16 but some lines lost up to USC11. Brighter - Ranged between steady to USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC12. Mediums - KTDA mediums were firm with a few invoices advancing by up to USC14 following quality while plantation mediums lost up to USC13. Lower Mediums - Met irregular interest varying between firm to USC17 dearer to easier by USC6. Plainer - Ranged between firm to USC9 dearer to easier by USC18.

PDUST: Best - Mostly steady to USC16 above previous levels but a few lines lost up to USC6. Brighter - Were irregular varying between firm to USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC6 with a few invoices shedding up to USC21. Mediums - KTDA mediums were fully firm on last rates while plantation mediums met irregular interest and varied between steady to USC8 dearer to easier by a similar margin. Lower Medium - Advanced by up to USC14 but a few invoices shed up to USC10. Plainer - were steady to USC24 dearer.

DUST1: Best - Held firm to USC6 dearer. Brighter - Steady to USC8 above last prices. Mediums - KTDA mediums advanced by USC2 to USC7 while plantation mediums saw irregular enquiry appreciating by up to USC10 to USC8 below previous rates. Lower Medium - Ranged between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by USC5. Plainer - Well competed for and advanced by up to USC18.

In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs were steady while others tended easier with PFs firm. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings held value with similar DUSTs steady. Other Fannings barely maintained while DUSTs held value. BMFs were readily absorbed.

BANGLADESH AUCTION OF 25TH APRIL 2022

CTC LEAF: 17,730 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with quite a good demand.

BROKENS: Well-made Medium Brokens were in strong demand and generally sold above Brokers' price ideas and fetching between Tk.235/- and Tk.245/- per kg. Smaller Brokens particularly well the brightest varieties were strongly competed for and sold substantially above valuations and prices varied between Tk. 245/- and Tk.255/- per kg. Other types were also well supported and rates for these ranged between Tk. 225/- and Tk.230/- per kg. Plainer types met with fair demand and sold between Tk.208/- and Tk.215/- per kg. with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective market and proved difficult of sale and generally sold around Tk. 130/- to Tk. 155/- per kg with quite heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well-made good liquoring varieties were in strong demand and realised rates between Tk.240/- and Tk. 250/- per kg. Medium varieties met with a good demand at rates between Tk. 220/ and Tk. 230/- per kg. Plainer types met with fair interest and could be sold between Tk. 210/- and Tk. 215/- per kg. However, there were some withdrawals. BLF teas were difficult of sale and prices for these ranged between Tk. 130/- and Tk. 155/- per kg with heavy withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 3,379 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with strong demand. Good liquoring Ds and CDs met with good competition and sold at a range between Tk. 280/- and Tk.428/-. Others also sold well in line with quality. However, PDs and RDs were less in demand and sold Tk. 5/- to Tk.10/- below Brokers' valuation with fair withdrawals. BLF Dusts saw only some interest but ranged between Tk.170/- and Tk.200/-. Loose tea buyers strongly operated on well-made popular marks whilst Blenders were selective only for bright liquoring varieties.

COMMENTS: This was the first sale of the season with a large participation by the buyers. Well-made teas backed by useful liquors attracted strong interest from the market especially from the Loose tea buyers. Other types met with a fairly good demand but sold at lower rates than Brokers' price ideas. BLF teas were discriminated against and where sold recorded a sharp drop from Brokers' price ideas. The Loose tea buyers were the dominant operators in this sale with some interest from the Blenders.




