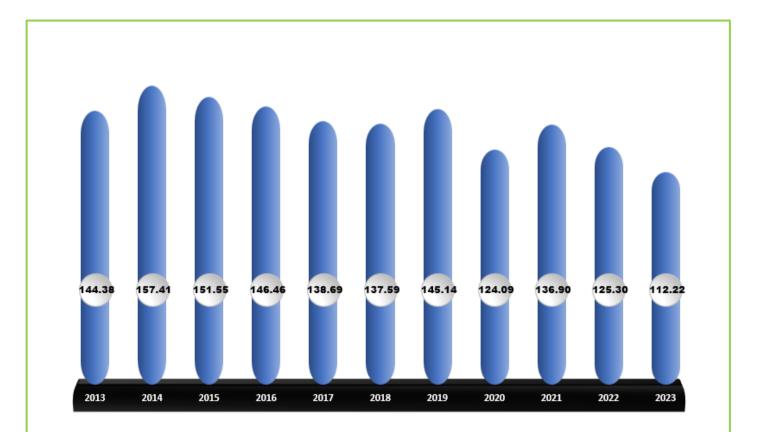

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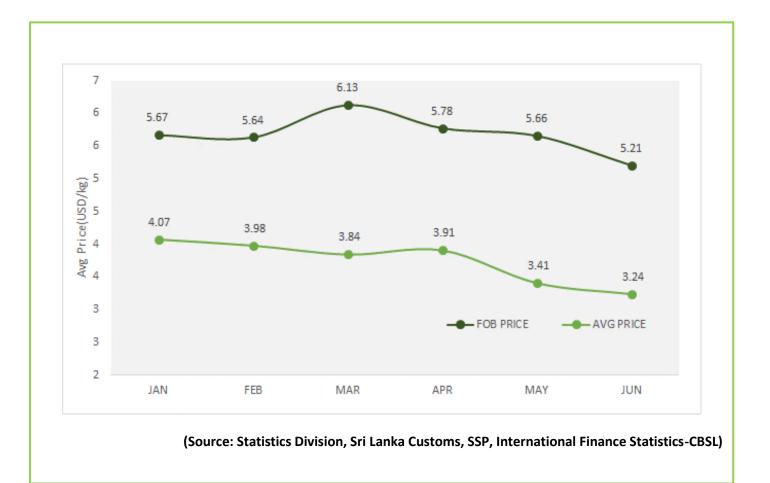

Mombasa Auction Demand: Fairly good general demand

Sri Lanka Tea Production for the month of June 2023 amounted to 23.00 Mn/Kg, vis-à-vis 20.15 Mn/Kg in 2022. (+2.85 Mn/Kg). Cumulative crop to end June 2023 was 134.42 Mn/Kg, compared with 132.93 Mn/Kg in 2022. (+1.49 Mn/Kg)

Elevation wise analysis shows that for the month of June 2023, High, Medium, and Low Growns recorded an increase of 1.55 Mn/Kg, 1.11 Mn/Kgs and 0.19 Mn/Kg respectively in comparison to the corresponding month in the previous year.

CTC's recorded 2.08 Mn/Kg for the month of June 2023 compared to 1.53 Mn/Kg the previous year, which recorded an increase of 0.55 Mn/Kg.

Sri Lanka Tea Exports - Total quantity of tea exported for the month of June 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 21.41 Mn/kg, recording a decrease of 2.16 Mn/kg (-9.18%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,568.97 vis-à-vis LKR 1,779.63 (LKR -210.66). Total export earnings recorded a decrease of -LKR 8.36 billion (-19.93%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

CROP AND WEATHER (FOR THE PERIOD 10TH – 16TH JULY 2023)

The Western planting districts experienced bright mornings followed by scattered evening showers whilst the Nuwara Eliya's reported sunny conditions throughout. The Department of Meteorology forecasts heavy showers in both regions. The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported clear weather conditions.

The Low growns reported bright weather throughout. Heavy rain is to be expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa districts.

The Western, Nuwara Eliya and Uva districts maintained their crop intakes whilst the Udapussellawa and Low growns recorded a decline.

Fairly good general demand for the 268,995 packages (17,788,700.00 kilos) in the market with 45.15% remaining unsold.

There was more and useful interest from Afghanistan and Bazaar with Kazakhstan and other CIS states strong. Pakistan Packers improved enquiry while Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Egyptian Packers, UK and Russia maintained activity. Local Packers were more active while Sudan and Iran quiet. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

BP1 : Best – Saw more competition and were steady to dearer by up to USC58. Brighter – Most teas held value but select lines advanced by USC10 and USC20. Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm where sold with plantation mediums irregular varying between steady to USC7 dearer to easier by USC14. Lower Medium – Mainly firm to USC10 above previous levels with a few teas appreciating by USC18 but select invoices lost up to USC27. Plainer – Were steady to dearer by up to USC33.

Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC10. Plainer – Were well competed for at steady to USC28 above last levels.

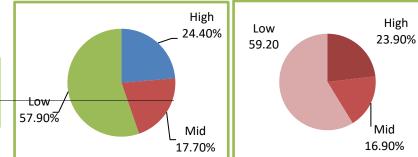

SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS – JUNE 2023

Total quantity of tea exported for the month of June 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 21.41 Mn/kg, recording a decrease of 2.16 Mn/kg (-9.18%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,568.97 vis-à-vis LKR 1,779.63 (LKR -210.66). Total export earnings recorded a decrease of -LKR 8.36 billion (-19.93%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

Cumulative exports for the period January to June 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 112.22 Mn/kg, showing a decline of -13.08 Mn/Kg (-10.44%) compared to last year. The FOB price per Kg for January to June 2023 recorded LKR 1,870.66 vis-à-vis LKR 1,310.74 for the corresponding period in 2022 (LKR +559.92). Total export value for the period under reference showed an increase of LKR 45.69 billion (27.82%) compared to 2022.

Equivalent USD export earnings for the cumulative period January to June 2023 amounted to approximately USD 633.97 million compared with 580.44 million in the same period last year showing an increase of approximately USD 53.53 million.

Country wise analysis of exports reveals that Iraq has emerged as the largest export destination from Sri Lanka followed by Turkey and Russia.
