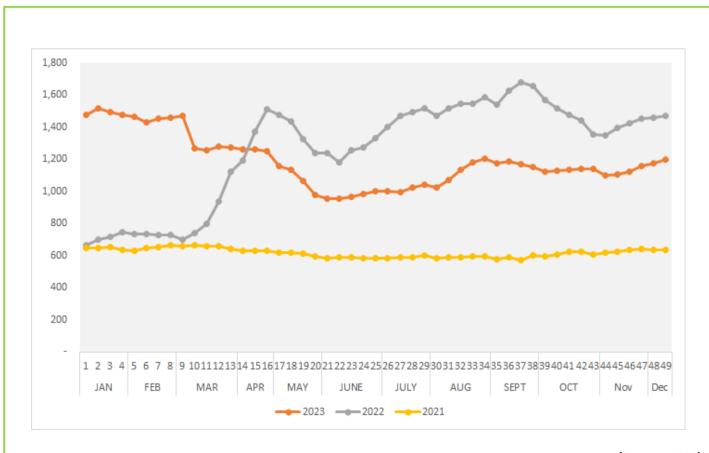

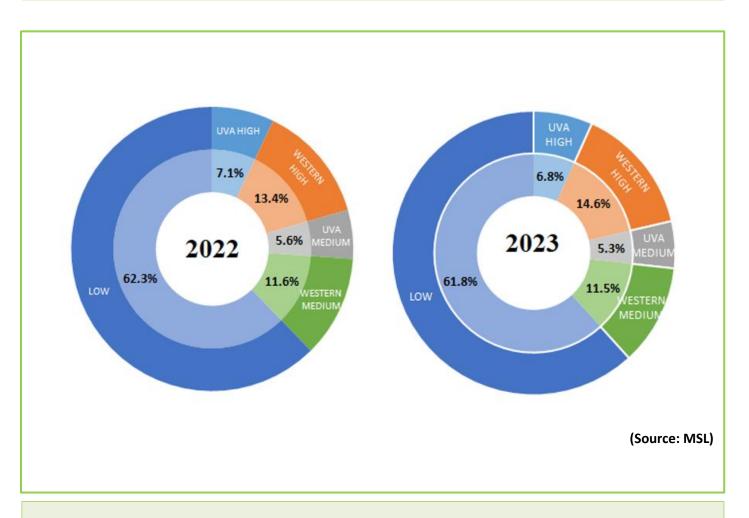


WEEKLY COMPARISON OF AVERAGE TEA PRICE (IN RS/KG) UPTO SALE NO.49 2021-2023

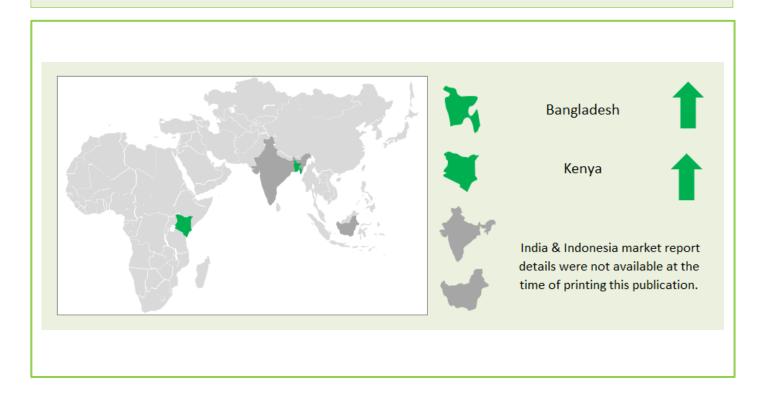

Sri Lanka Tea Production for the month of November 2023 amounted to 19.59 Mn/Kg, vis-à-vis 20.24 Mn/Kg in 2022. (-0.66 Mn/Kg). Cumulative crop to end November 2023 was 236.03 Mn/Kg, compared with 231.87 Mn/Kg in 2022. (+4.16 Mn/Kg)

Elevation wise analysis shows that for the month of November 2023, High & Medium Growns recorded an increase of +0.18 Mn/Kg, +0.31 whereas the Low Growns recorded a decline of -1.15 Mn/Kg respectively in comparison to the corresponding month in the previous year.

CTC's recorded 1.72 Mn/Kg for the month of November 2023 compared to 1.83 Mn/Kg the previous year, which recorded a decrease of -0.11 Mn/Kg.

Sri Lanka Tea Exports - Total quantity of tea exported for the month of November 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 21.46 Mn/kg, recording an increase of +2.18 Mn/kg (+11.33%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,725.77 vis-à-vis LKR 1,992.05 (LKR -266.28). Total export earnings recorded a decrease of -LKR 1.37 billion (-3.56%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

The Western planting districts experienced sunny mornings followed by rains in the evenings whilst the Nuwara Eliya's reported occasional showers throughout the week. The department of meteorology forecasts misty conditions and heavy showers in Nuwara Eliya.

The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported clear mornings followed by evening showers. Scattered showers are to be expected in Uva.

The Low grown's experienced bright mornings with showers in the evenings. Misty mornings and heavy showers are to be expected in Sabaragamuwa and misty conditions in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa planting districts. All districts maintained their crop intakes.

MOMBASA AUCTION OF 11TH & 13TH DECEMBER 2023

There was good general demand in the market at irregular rates for the 255,158 packages (17,065,234.00 kilos) available in the market; 38.29% was unsold.

Pakistan Packers were strong with more enquiry from Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries. Bazaar and UK maintained activity with Kazakhstan and other CIS states active but selective. Afghanistan were more selective while Egyptian Packers lent more and strong support. There was increased interest from South Sudan while Iran showed some activity. Russia was less active with Sudan absent. Local Packers showed more enquiry while Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

BP1: Best – Met very irregular demand and varied from USC104 dearer for some lines to easier by up to USC113. Brighter – Saw good enquiry ranging between USC67 above last rates with some invoices advancing by up to USC102; some lines were discounted by up to USC14. Mediums – KTDA mediums lost up to USC18 where sold with Plantation mediums irregular at USC50 above previous rates for some lines while others were discounted by up to USC10. Lower Medium – Firm to USC30 below last levels but some teas gained up to USC8. Plainer – Met less enquiry at mostly easier rates with a number of teas discounted by up to USC16.

PF1: Best – Saw irregular support at firm to USC20 above last rates to easier by up to USC33. Brighter – Steady to USC11 dearer to USC6 below last prices for select teas. Mediums – Some KTDA mediums gained by up to USC14 while others were mostly easier; Plantation mediums were irregular and ranged between firm to USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC18. Lower Medium – Irregularly discounted by up to USC14 but a few lines held steady to USC2 above previous levels. Plainer – Saw less demand at irregularly easier levels with some teas USC18 below previous rates but select invoices gained up to USC18.

PDUST: Best – Irregular interest at firm to USC28 dearer to easier by up to USC20. Brighter – Met strong enquiry at irregular rates advancing by up to USC17 but a few lines lost up to USC7. Mediums – KTDA mediums saw irregular activity ranging between steady to USC35 above previous rates to easier by up to USC8; Plantation mediums were irregular and lost up to USC7 with some lines discounted by up to USC40 but select invoices advanced by up to USC9. Lower Medium – Saw less enquiry at irregularly easier levels and shed up to USC27 but a few lines gained up to USC10. Plainer – Met strong but irregular absorption at firm to USC23 above previous rates to easier by up to USC11.

DUST1: Best – Saw strong interest at firm to USC13 dearer to easier by up to USC8. Brighter – Were steady to mostly dearer by up to USC35 but a few lines lost up to USC8. Mediums – KTDA mediums saw good absorption at firm to USC3 above previous levels to easier by USC14 with a few lines discounted by up to USC28 while Plantation mediums were steady to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC16. Lower Medium – Were less sought after at mostly easier rates with some lines up to USC21 below previous levels but a few invoices gained up to USC14. Plainer – Irregular absorption at USC16 dearer to easier by up to USC20.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1) - In the Secondary Catalogues best BPs appreciated while others were discounted with PFs irregular but on balance dearer. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings appreciated with similar DUSTs dearer. Other Fannings tended easier while DUSTs were marginally dearer. BMFs were well absorbed.

BANGLADESH AUCTION OF 18TH DECEMBER 2023

CTC LEAF: 76,102 packages of tea on offer met with a fairly good demand.

BROKENS: Well made Brokens were quite a strong feature and often advanced in prices following competition. Other varieties met with a fair demand and were generally a little easier and there were some withdrawals. Plain teas continued to attract less interest and prices accordingly eased further. There were quite heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with less demand than last with a decline in price and heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: A few good liquoring Fannings were quite a strong market and were firm to slightly dearer. Other varieties met with a fair demand, but prices were about steady to little easier. However, there were quite heavy withdrawals. Plain teas followed a similar trend as of last week with heavier withdrawals. BLF teas met with less demand than last with a decline in price and heavy withdrawals.

DUST: 15,811 packages of tea on offer met with fair demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with a fair demand and sold Tk.5/- to Tk.8/- less than last levels. Mediums were an easier market and sold around Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- less than last following quality. Plain and BLF Dusts again continued to be difficult of sale and with heavy withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose tea buyers were selective.

COMMENTS: Reprinted teas from previous sales constituted the bulk of the offerings and owing to lack of interest for these teas, withdrawal percentage was heavy. Furthermore, there was also easing of price levels. The fresh Invoices, however, were well supported at irregular rates. Blenders lent fairly good support and there was some interest from the Loose tea buyers. Dusts were an easier market with heavy withdrawals.

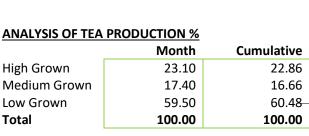

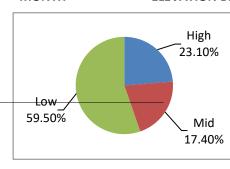

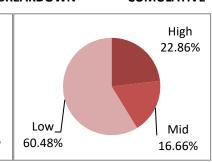

SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS – NOVEMBER 2023

Total quantity of tea exported for the month of November 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 21.46 Mn/kg, recording an increase of +2.18 Mn/kg (+11.33%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,725.77 vis-à-vis LKR 1,992.05 (LKR -266.28). Total export earnings recorded a decrease of -LKR 1.37 billion (-3.56%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

Cumulative exports for the period January to November 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 221.16 Mn/kg, showing a decline of -9.73 Mn/Kg (-4.21%) compared to last year. The FOB price per Kg for January to November 2023 recorded LKR 1,772.41 vis-à-vis LKR 1,611.72 for the corresponding period in 2022 (LKR +160.69). Total export value for the period under reference showed an increase of LKR 19.86 billion (5.34%) compared to 2022.

Equivalent USD export earnings for the cumulative period January to November 2023 amounted to approximately USD 1.20 billion compared with 1.17 billion in the same period last year showing an increase of approximately USD 29.89 Million.

Country wise analysis of exports reveals that Iraq has emerged as the largest export destination from Sri Lanka followed by Turkey and Russia.
