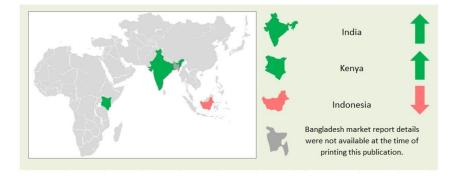

The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported bright conditions. Misty mornings followed by evening showers are to be expected in Uva. The Low grown's experienced sunny weather throughout. Misty mornings followed by evening showers are to be expected an increase in their crop intakes except for the Westerns which reported a decline.
