



BOPF

Best Western's selected high priced teas were sharply lower. Below best were firm to Rs.40/per kg lower. Plainer sorts declined by Rs.40/- per kg and more. Nuwara Eliya's were firm. Uda Pussellawa's were eased by Rs.30/- per kg following quality. Uva's were Rs.70-80/- per kg lower.

CTC LEAF

DEMAND: Selective demand on the range of teas on offer.

MARKET: The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 70.48% (754,770.93kgs) of the total offering of 1,070,832.96Kgs.

LARGER BROKEN: Select invoices of best larger broken sold at irregular prices, good teas were barely steady, better medium & medium teas sold steady to easier whilst plainer teas were discounted with only a few invoices sold at easier prices by a couple of rupees. Larger volumes of medium category larger broken remain unsold.

MEDIUM BROKEN: Good, best and better medium teas selectively sold at barely steady to easier prices whilst medium & plainer teas sold at firm prices.

SMALLER BROKEN: Best teas fetched dearer prices at irregular levels following quality and competition. Good teas at the lower end declined substantially whilst the top end was steady. Better medium, medium & plainer sold barely steady to easier. However, there were some unsold teas in the medium & plainer teas.

FANNING: Very few lines of fanning were on offer in the best teas which sold at steady prices. Reminders sold barley steady to easier.

ORTHODOX LEAF

DEMAND: Good demand.

MARKET: The high grown whole leaf grades sold fully firm to dearer. The high grown broken sold irregularly. Fanning sold firm. Other whole leaf, broken & fanning sold at irregularly around last price levels.

CTC DUST

DEMAND: Good Demand.

MARKET: CTC dust offer this week was at 316,984.26Kgs of which 261,748.65kgs were sold (82.57%).

PD: Best category PD met with firm to dearer prices selectively on quality and competition. Good teas sold fully firm. Remainders sold at barely steady to easier prices.

RD: Best & Good category sold barely steady to easier. Better Medium, medium and plainer teas sold easier by Rs. 1 to 2.

ORTHODOX DUST

DEMAND: Good demand.

MARKET: High grown primary dust continues to sell at irregular and dearer prices on competition. Secondary teas sold barely steady. Other category primary dust firm to dearer. Secondary grades sold barely steady, powdery and fibrous sorts continue to be discounted. **(Courtesy - J. Thomas & Co. Pvt. Ltd)** CTC LEAF: 23,685 packages of tea on offer met with a strong but selective demand.

BROKENS: Best Brokens were very strongly competed for and mostly sold above valuations. Below best met with a good demand and sold in line with quality with some withdrawals. Lesser quality met with much lower bids than valuations and met with heavy withdrawals particularly the plainer varieties. BLF teas were mostly neglected as bids were much lower than price ideas.

FANNINGS: Best Fannings met with a strong demand and were often dearer following quality. Below Best/Good varieties met with a fairly good demand, but buyers were somewhat selective in their purchase. As a result, quite a few teas were withdrawn having failed to meet the valuations. Medium teas met with a limited demand and few teas sold at valuations. The bulk of it was withdrawn. Plain varieties met with a very discriminating market and were mostly withdrawn owing to low bids. BLF teas were mostly neglected as bids were much lower than price ideas.

DUST: 4,840 packages of tea on offer met with a good demand. Good liquoring Ds and CDs met with good competition and generally sold above Brokers' valuation fetching between Tk.419/- and Tk.295/-. PDs and RDs were well supported and rates for these ranged between Tk. 245/-and Tk.280/-. BLF Dusts proved difficult of sale. Loose tea buyers lent good support whilst Blenders were selective in their purchase.

COMMENTS: This was the First sale of the season which met with a very strong demand from the Loose tea buyers for black, well-made teas backed by strong useful liquors. Other varieties met with a discriminating market and only a fair weight was sold with large withdrawals. Blenders were very selective. Good liquoring Dusts particularly CDs were a strong feature of the sale.
