





Best Western's declined by Rs.50/- per kg and more. Below best few coloury invoices were firm whilst others declined by Rs.50/- per kg. Plainer types too followed a similar trend. Nuwara Eliya's were easier. Uda Pussellawa's lost Rs.50/- per kg. Uva's were firm to Rs.50/- per kg lower.

Sri Lanka Tea Sale Averages for the Month of May 2024 recorded Rs. 1,266.86 (USD 4.23) vis-àvis Rs.1,055.45 (USD 3.40) (+Rs.211.41) in 2023. High Growns for the month of May was Rs.1,162.31 as against Rs.996.79 (+Rs.165.52) in 2023. Medium Growns recorded Rs.1,074.79 vis-à-vis Rs.924.84 (+Rs.149.95) in 2023. Low Growns achieved Rs.1,367.80 vis-à-vis Rs.1,120.52 (+Rs.247.28) in 2023. Cumulative figure for January / May stood at Rs.1,270.33 vis-à-vis Rs1,283.34 in 2023. High Growns recorded Rs.1,157.41 as against Rs.1,240.79 in 2023. Medium Grown was Rs.1,101.12 vis-à-vis Rs.1,106.48 in 2023. Low Growns recorded Rs.1,363.55 vis-à-vis Rs.1,345.20 in 2023. Mombasa Auction of 03rd / 04th June 2024

Fairly good general demand prevailed for the 268,460 packages (17,967,428.00 kilos) on offer; 45.82% remained unsold.

Pakistan Packers lent useful support but at lower levels while Afghanistan, Bazaar, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained interest. Egyptian Packers showed good enquiry but at lower levels with UK active but selective. Kazakhstan and other CIS states lent more support while Russia, Sudan and South Sudan maintained enquiry. Iran were absent while Local Packers reduced activity. Somalia continued active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1: Best – Irregular interest and varied between firm to USC44 dearer with selected invoices appreciating by up to USC80 to easier by up to USC21 with a few lines losing USC76. Brighter – Saw most teas steady with some lines shedding up to USC99 to sell at reserve price levels. Mediums – KTDA mediums were neglected with a few select teas absorbed at last levels. Plantation mediums were firm to USC12 dearer with select invoices gaining up to USC75 but a few lines shed up to USC19. Lower Medium – Were irregular varying between steady to USC20 dearer to USC19 below previous rates. Plainer – Met improved competition at firm to USC40 dearer.

PF1: Best – Were irregular ranging between steady to USC43 dearer to easier by up to USC40. Brighter – Firm to USC13 above last levels. Mediums – KTDA mediums held value for most lines with some teas irregular varying between USC10 dearer to easier by USC7. Plantation mediums ranged between firm to USC29 dearer to USC20 below previous prices. Lower Medium – Saw some lines appreciating by up to USC8 while others lost up to USC14. Plainer – Firm to dearer by up to USC26 to easier by up to USC17.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST: Best – Were irregular varying between firm to USC13 dearer with select teas gaining USC31 to easier by up to USC13. Brighter – Ranged between steady to USC4 dearer to easier by a similar margin. Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm at last levels while plantation mediums varied between USC10 dearer to easier by USC7. Lower Medium –Irregular with some teas advancing by up to USC13 while others lost up to USC10. Plainer – Varied between USC16 dearer to USC15 below previous prices.

DUST1: Best – Irregular ranged between steady to USC12 dearer to easier by USC13 with selected lines shedding USC30. Brighter – Firm to USC10 below last levels. Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady to USC9 easier with plantation mediums irregular ranging between firm to USC8 dearer and select teas appreciated by USC32 to easier by USC4 and a few lines lost USC42. Lower Medium – Firm to USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC8. Plainer – Ranged between USC14 dearer to easier by USC8.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1): In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs were firm with others tending dearer while PFs were easier. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings held value with similar DUSTs about steady. Other Fannings were irregular while DUSTs were well absorbed at firm to dearer levels. BMFs were well absorbed.

CTC LEAF

DEMAND: Strong demand.

MARKET: The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 98.15% (599,180.73kgs) of the total offering of 610,450.31Kgs.

BEST: Larger broken at the lower declined by Rs. 8 to 10, whilst the select best invoices sold firm. The medium broken grade sold dearer by Rs. 5 at the lower end whilst the top end, select invoices fetched dearer price following quality and competition. Smaller broken & fanning met with good demand and appreciated on quality and competition by Rs. 10 to 15 or more.

GOOD: Improved strong demand was witnessed in this category. The larger broken at the lower end sold dearer by up to Rs. 10, the top end sold barely steady. Medium grade at the bottom end saw a price escalation by up to Rs. 15, top end sold dearer by Rs. 9. Smaller broken in this section, the lower end sold dearer by Rs. 15 to 16, whilst top end sold steady. Fanning saw a substantial increase in prices.

BETTER MEDIUM: All sorts in this category sold dearer by Rs. 8 to 16, except for the fanning grade which saw an increment of Rs 6 to 7.

MARKET: The high grown whole leaf & broken grades sold at fully firm prices. Fanning sold at steady prices. Other whole leaf grades sold firm to dearer on quality, broken grade appreciated on competition particularly at the lower end. Fanning too saw an increment in prices by Rs. 3 to 6.

CTC DUST

DEMAND: Good improved demand.

MARKET: CTC dust offer this week was at 222,273.56Kgs of which 213,927.07kgs were sold (96.24%).

BEST: Bolder dust sold dearer by Rs. 2 to 6, RD, were firm whilst the finer dust saw a decline in prices.

GOOD: The lower end of PD & RD fetched about Rs. 8 to 10 dearer whilst the top end remained firm to dearer. The finer dust in this category saw a price increase of Rs. 4 to 6.

BETTER MEDIUM: PD grade sold Rs. 2 to 4 dearer; RD saw an increment of Rs. 3 to 10, especially at the top end. Finer grades sold Rs. 5 to 7 dearer.
