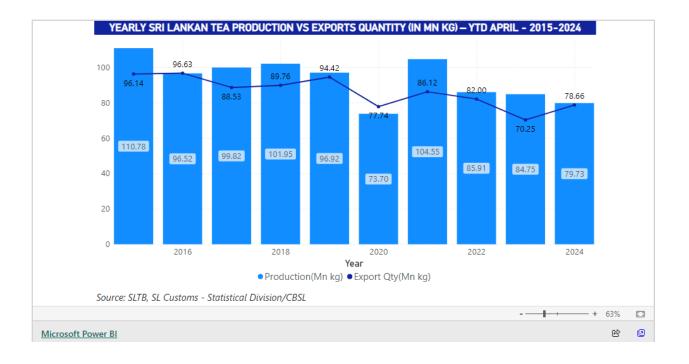


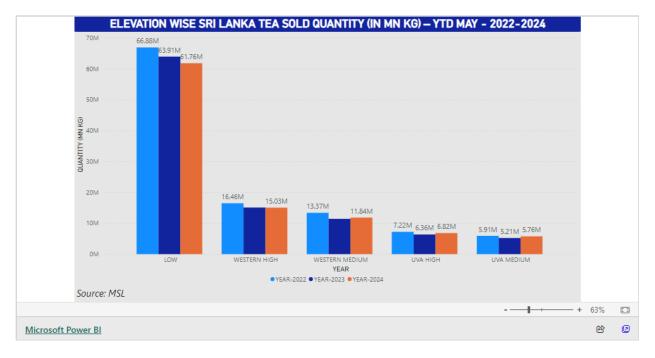

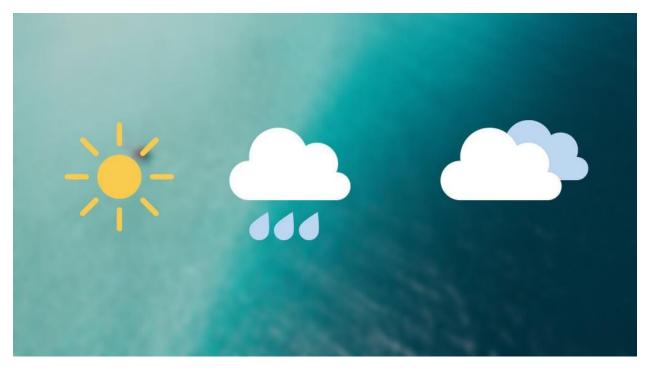

The Western and Nuwara Eliya planting districts experienced gloomy conditions with scattered showers. The Department of Meteorology forecasts heavy showers and winds in the Western region.

The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported bright conditions throughout. Evening/Night showers are to be expected in Uva.

The Low grown's experienced scattered showers. Heavy rains are to be expected in the Low grown district.

The Nuwara Eliya, Uva/Udapussellawa's maintained their crop intakes whilst the Western and Low Grown districts reported a decline.

Other Markets



Mombasa Auction of 10th / 11th June 2024

There was fairly good general demand for the 276,659 packages (18,556,820.50 kilos) available with 45.99% unsold.

Egyptian Packers lent more support with maintained enquiry from Pakistan Packers, Bazaar and Afghanistan. Kazakhstan, other CIS states and UK saw more but selective interest while Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries reduced activity. Sudan and South Sudan were more active with some interest from Russia. Local Packers showed improved support while Iran were quiet. Somalia continued active at the lower end of the market. **BP1:** Best – Were firm to USC36 dearer with select lines advancing by USC57 and USC78, some lines however eased by up to USC4. Brighter – Mostly steady with select invoices appreciating by USC9 and USC21. Mediums – KTDA mediums saw a few lines absorbed at reserve prices while the majority remained unsold. Plantation mediums met improved competition and gained up to USC40 with select invoices dearer by USC86. Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC16 above last prices with select improved invoices gaining USC43 and USC60 to easier by up to USC21. Plainer – Varied between USC20 dearer to easier by USC12.

PF1: Best – Met improved competition and appreciated by up to USC29, a few lines however lost up to USC18. Brighter – Firm to USC13 dearer. Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady at previous levels while plantation mediums were irregular varying between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by up to USC26. Lower Medium – Saw some lines gaining up to USC8 while others lost up to USC14. Plainer – Irregular with some teas advancing by up to USC20 while others lost up to USC9.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST: Best – Were firm to USC34 above previous levels to easier by up to USC7. Brighter – Steady at last levels. Mediums – KTDA mediums held value while plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC14. Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC18 dearer to easier by up to USC5. Plainer – Were irregular varying between steady to USC14 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

DUST1: Best – Ranged between USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Brighter – Were firm to USC12 above last prices. Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady at previous levels while plantation mediums lost up to USC8 with a few invoices discounted by USC34 and USC54. Lower

Medium – Were irregular and varied between firm to dearer by up to USC6 to easier by up to USC3. Plainer – Saw some teas advance by up to USC8 while others shed up to USC10.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1): In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs held value with PFs firm. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were steady while similar DUSTs were dearer. Other Fannings were firm with DUSTs selling at last levels. BMFs were readily absorbed.

CTC LEAF

DEMAND: Good demand.

MARKET: The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 94.13% (631,538.87kgs) of the total offering of 670,945.95Kgs.

BEST: Larger, medium & smaller broken sold at barely steady to easier levels. Fanning at the lower end sold easier by Rs 4 whilst select lines at the top end sold dearer on competition.

GOOD: Larger broken in the lower end saw a price increase of Rs. 3, whilst the top end sold dearer by up to Rs. 8 on competition. Medium grade at the lower end increased substantially whilst the top end sold at firm prices, whilst the smaller broken sold dearer by Rs. 7 to 8. The fanning grade in this category at the lower end saw a steep decline, whilst top end sold steady.

BETTER MEDIUM: Larger broken sold barely steady to easier, medium & smaller broken sold dearer by Rs. 6 to 10. Fanning at the lower end eased substantially whilst the top end sold steady.

MEDIUM: Larger broken sold barely steady, Medium broken saw Rs. 4 to 6 dearer prices, whilst smaller broken fetched Rs. 6 to 8 dearer & fanning sold Rs. 3 to 5 dearer, especially the blacker sorts.

PLAINER: Large & Medium sold dearer by Rs. 3 to 5, larger gain was witnessed on the smaller broken whilst fanning sold dearer by up to Rs. 5.

The Major blender's absorption was at 51.59% of the total CTC leaf sold.

ORTHODOX LEAF

DEMAND: Good demand.

MARKET: The high grown clean well made whole leaf at the lower end sold firm, at the top eased following quality. Broken grade sold barely steady. Fanning sold at firm prices. Other whole leaves sold firm to dearer on quality, broken grades were barely steady, the lower end declined following quality. Fanning sold at firm to dearer prices.

CTC DUST

DEMAND: Good demand.

MARKET: CTC dust offer this week was at 241,735.82kgs of which 224,341.25kgs were sold (92.80%).

BEST: Bolder dust sold easier at the lower end substantially, whilst others sold barely steady. However, few select invoices especially on the finer dust saw upward price movement on competition.

GOOD: All sorts sold irregularly around last levels.

BETTER MEDIUM: All sorts in this category too sold irregularly around last levels.
