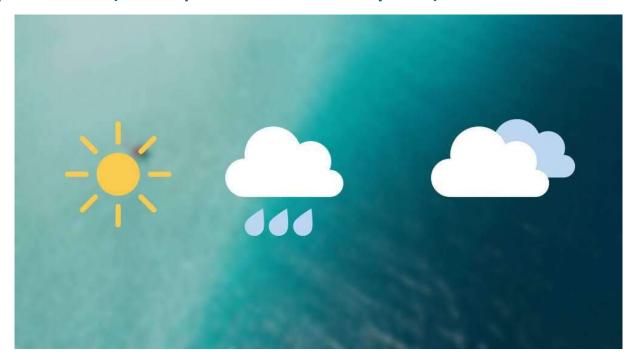

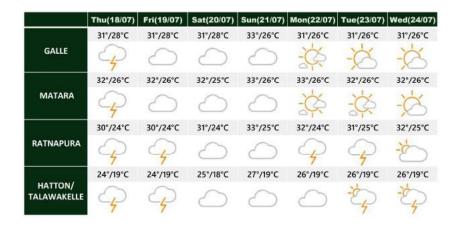
ECP Dryer trays need to have larger perforations on the top circuit and reduce in size towards the lower circuit.

The Western planting districts reported scattered evening showers whilst the Nuwara Eliya's experienced occasional showers throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology forecasts heavy showers in both regions. The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported bright conditions with scattered showers. The Low grown's experienced sunny mornings followed by occasional evening showers. Heavy rains are to be expected in the Low grown districts. The Western, Nuwara Eliya and Uva's maintained their crop intakes whilst the Uda Pussellawa and Low grown districts reported a slight decline.

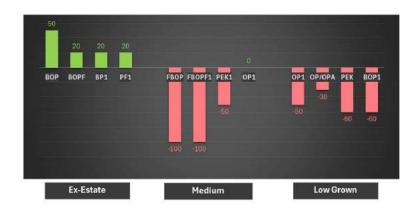

Cumulative crop to end June 2024 was 127.43 Mn/Kg, compared with 134.67 Mn/Kg in 2023. (-7.23 Mn/Kg) In June 2024, an elevation-wise analysis shows that High Growns decreased by -0.68 Mn/Kg, whilst Medium and Low Growns increased by +0.31 Mn/Kg and +0.30 Mn/Kg respectively, compared to the same period in 2023. CTC's recorded 2.12 Mn/Kg for the month of June 2024 compared to 2.08 Mn/Kg the previous year, which recorded a drop of -0.70 Mn/Kg.

Total quantity of tea exported for the month of June 2024 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 20.96 Mn/kg, recording a decrease of -0.46 Mn/kg (-2.14%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,765.01 vis-à-vis LKR 1,568.97 (+LKR 196.04). Total export earnings recorded an increase of LKR 3.39 billion (10.09%) in 2024 as against the same month last year. Cumulative exports for the period January to June 2024 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 119.11 Mn/kg, showing an increase of 6.89 Mn/Kg (6.14%) compared to last year. The FOB price per Kg for January to June 2024 recorded LKR 1,771.05 vis-à-vis LKR 1,870.66 for the corresponding period in 2023 (-LKR 99.61). Total export value for the period under reference showed an increase of +LKR 1.03 billion (0.49%) compared to 2023. Equivalent USD export earnings for the cumulative period January to June 2024 amounted to approximately

USD 687.04 million compared with 633.99 million in the same period last year showing an increase of approximately USD 53.04 million. Country wise analysis of exports reveals that Iraq has emerged as the largest export destination from Sri Lanka followed by Russia and U.A.E.

Other Markets



Mombasa Auction of 15th / 16th July 2024

Fair demand prevailed for the 296,403 packages (19,991,106.00 kilos) on offer with 55.32% unsold.

Pakistan Packers showed useful support with more activity from Egyptian Packers. UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained interest while Bazaar and Afghanistan saw reduced enquiry. Kazakhstan, other CIS states and Russia lent more support with Sudan and South Sudan active. Local Packers were less active with Iran absent. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best – Saw more enquiry at firm to USC46 above previous prices. Brighter – Steady to dearer by up to USC18. Mediums – KTDA mediums held value where sold while plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC16. Lower Medium – Were irregular ranging between firm to dearer by USC15 to easier by up to USC17. Plainer – Varied between steady to USC15 dearer to USC26 below last levels.

PF1:

Best – Were irregular but mostly dearer by up to USC12 with some lines discounted by up to USC7. Brighter – Gained up to USC14. Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC6 easier and a number of teas were neglected while plantation mediums were steady to USC13 above previous rates. Lower Medium – Irregular ranging between USC17 dearer to USC13 below previous rates. Plainer – Varied between firm to USC19 dearer to easier by up to USC17.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Varied between steady to USC22 dearer to easier by up to USC10. Brighter – Firm to USC5 dearer. Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady with a few invoices dearer by USC9 but a number of teas remained unsold. Plantation mediums were irregular ranging between firm to USC18 dearer to USC6 below last prices. Lower Medium – Appreciated by up to USC21. Plainer – Were mostly easier by up to USC27 but a few teas advanced by up to USC5.

DUST1:

Best – Met improved interest and gained up to USC15 with selected lines dearer by USC132. Brighter – Irregularly dearer by up to USC20. Mediums – Most KTDA mediums held value with some teas irregular ranging between USC6 dearer to easier by USC4 and others were neglected. Plantation mediums Varied between firm to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Lower Medium – Saw some teas appreciate by up to USC14 while others lost up to USC11. Plainer – Varied between USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC13.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs tended easier with others steady while PFs held value. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were steady at previous rates with similar DUSTs dearer. Other Fannings were firm while DUSTs gained. BMFs were well absorbed. (Courtesy - Africa Tea Brokers Limited)

CTC LEAF

DEMAND: Good Demand at easier price levels.

MARKET: The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 81.87% (1,572,014.57kgs) of the total offering of 1,920,194.87Kgs.

BEST: Modest quantity of larger broken sold at irregular prices. Medium broken sold dearer on quality and competition erratically. Smaller broken prices were irregularly easier except for select invoices at the top end sold firm to dearer. Fanning met with firm to dearer prices especially at the lower end and saw an increase in line with competition.

GOOD: Limited volume of larger broken on offer sold Rs. 3 easier at the lower end whilst the top end fetched about 8 rupees dearer on competition. Medium broken saw irregular prices. Smaller broken grades sold at barely steady prices. Fanning sold dearer on quality and competition.

BETTER MEDIUM: Larger broken sold easier by Rs. 2 to 3. Medium, smaller broken and fanning at the lower end saw a decline by Rs. 2 to 3 whilst at the top end saw a surge and prices increased substantially.

MEDIUM: Select larger broken at the lower end sold dearer by Rs. 4 whilst larger volume sold easier by Rs. 3 to 5. Medium broken sold easier by Rs. 3 to 4. Smaller broken sold barely steady to easier.

PLAINER: Larger broken sold easier by Rs. 2 to 4 remaining grades declined by Rs. 2 to 5.

The Major blenders absorption was at 57.06% of the total CTC leaf sold.

ORTHODOX LEAF

DEMAND: Fair demand.

MARKET: The high grown whole leaf sold easier following quality, except for select few invoices which sold dearer on competition. Broken grades too saw a decline in prices following quality. Fanning however, held to last sold prices. Other whole leaf sold barely steady to easier with broken grades seeing a sharp decline in prices. Fanning at the lower end eased whilst the top end held to firm prices.

CTC DUST

DEMAND: Continued weak demand.

MARKET: CTC dust offer this week was at 530,787.36Kgs of which 329,809.76kgs were sold (62.14%).

BEST: All grades saw a sharp decline in prices except for a few odd invoices of the finer dust which sold at steady prices.

GOOD: PD eased substantially easier whilst, RD sold at barely steady. Finer dust too saw a steep falling away in prices.

BETTER MEDIUM: All sorts in this category declined by Rs. 4 to 5 or more with larger weight of teas remaining unsold.

MEDIUM: All sorts sold at easier by Rs. 4 to 5.

PLAINER: This category of teas sold easier by Rs. 3 to 5, with a larger percentage of teas remaining unsold.

ORTHODOX DUST

DEMAND: Fair demand at easier prices.

MARKET: High grown primary sold easier as per quality. The secondary sold easier as per quality. Other category primary dust too saw a decline in prices especially at the top end, secondary dust sold at barely steady to easier prices.
